<p>Employment - Employment, office, trade, profession or vocation, carried on for profit or gain by you or your partner</p>

<p>Sponsorship - Any payment or provision of any other financial benefit (other than from Baginton Parish Council) made or provided within the 12 months before your declaration of interests or any amended declaration in respect of any expenses incurred by you in carrying out duties as a member, or towards your election expenses. This includes any payment or financial benefit from a trade union within the meaning of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992.</p>
<p>Contracts - Any contract which is made between you or your partner (or a firm or body corporate in which you or your partner is a partner or a director, or in the securities of which you or your partner has a beneficial interest) and the Baginton Parish Council</p> <p>(a) under which goods or services are to be provided or works are to be executed; and</p> <p>(b) which has not been fully discharged.</p>

Land - "Land, any beneficial interest in land which is within the area of the Baginton Parish Council, this excludes an easement, servitude, interest or right in or over land which does not carry with it a right for you or your partner (alone or jointly with another) to occupy the land or to receive income

Licences - Any licence (alone or jointly with others) for you or your partner to occupy land in the area of the Baginton Parish Council for a month or longer.

Corporate tenancies - Any tenancy where (to your knowledge)—

- (a) the landlord is the Baginton Parish Council; and
- (b) the tenant is a body in which you or your partner has a beneficial interest i.e. a firm or body corporate in which you or your partner is a partner or a director, or in the securities of which you or your partner has a beneficial interest.

Securities - which means, shares, debentures, debenture stock, loan stock, bonds, units of a collective investment scheme within the meaning of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 and other securities of any description, other than money deposited with a building society

Any beneficial interest in securities of a body held by you or your partner where—

- (a) that body (to your knowledge) has a place of business or land in the area of the Baginton Parish Council; and
- (b) either—
 - (i) the total nominal value of the securities exceeds £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that body; or
 - (ii) if the share capital of that body is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares of any one class in which you or your partner has a beneficial interest exceeds one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that class.

Other Interests Form

A matter being considered by the Baginton Parish Council where a decision in relation to that matter might reasonably be regarded as affecting you or a relevant person's well-being or financial position to a greater extent than the majority of other council tax payers, ratepayers or inhabitants of the ward affected by the decision;
